In the February session a card was made using a stamp that can be wet embossed. Embossing powders are available in many colours to create different effects. Yes - heat is an essential part of the process! It activates the embossing powder effects, whether that be to shine, mattify or gloss. Be careful when using a heat gun that you hold it a distance away. Once the card is embossed and the heat has been applied it becomes dry enough for colour to be added within your chosen design. As you can see you can adapt the design for different occasions.
